



#### 1 YAON (Hibiya Open-Air Concert Hall)

On the historic stage of Hibiya YAON, which has been instrumental in Japan's outdoor concert history, you will experience special collaboration concerts by The Music Park Orchestra and diverse musicians. \*Tickets required (free by lottery).

#### 2 KADAN (Second Flower Garden)

Located in the heart of Hibiya Park, this grassy area is home to a stage where the main attractions are live & workshops. You can enjoy the activities in a picnic mood while sitting on the grass.

#### 3 ONGAKUDO (Small Music Hall) Surrounded by trees and steeped in history, this music hall offers a variety of

concerts, from classic to pop music.

#### 4 KOTONOHA (Park View Garden)

This small stage is set in a rooftop garden overlooking Hibiya Park and the Imperial Palace. Enjoy concerts in a pleasant location where you can feel the breeze.

#### 5 HIROBA (Hibiya step open space)

An urban stage stands in a square surrounded by buildings. Various music performances will resonate through the streets of Hibiya.
