Hibiya Music Festival 2026 can also be enjoyed through live online streaming and on-demand replay. A special team of MCs will bring excitement to the festival both on-site and online.

Centered around Hibiya Park, home to “YAON” the sacred ground that has shaped the history of outdoor concerts in Japan, the festival has been held as a free event where anyone can experience wonderful music.

In its eighth year, while YAON undergoes renovation, Tokyo International Forum Hall A joins as a new venue, allowing the festival to expand further into the city. Admission and participation are free. Families across three generations can enjoy a comfortable space, top artists' live performances, and a variety of high-quality musical experiences—all at no cost.

This free event is made possible through crowdfunding, donations, and corporate sponsorships. Some may think, “Why not charge admission instead of relying on financial support?” But Hibiya Music Festival values being free of charge. We want to create an open space where people of all ages, genres, and tastes can encounter diverse music a place that sparks curiosity and helps more people discover the depth and joy of music.

We believe that music can transcend the boundaries we hold within ourselves ideas like “how things should be,” “how things have always been”, or “who we are.” Both the way we enjoy music and the way we share it can be freer. As a first step, we offer musical experiences for free. If you enjoy the festival, we encourage you to spend money on music in any form afterward. How You Can Help Official Goods & Crowdfunding

1. Donate at the Venue

Donation boxes are available at the “Official Goods & Crowdfunding Booth” and near performance exits. Donations start from ¥1,000. No special procedures are required. Early donors receive an original coffee drip pack (Kameda Blend Gold). Support via PayPay is also available at the crowdfunding booth.

2. Purchasing Official Goods

Our Official merchandise is available at the “Official Goods & Crowdfunding Booth.” Original T-shirts including venue-exclusive colors feature a list of participating artists and make memorable items.

3. Choose a Return Through Crowdfunding

On the crowdfunding project page, you can choose from various reward items, including official goods, artist collaborations, and experience-based rewards. Support is accepted until June 28 (Sun) at 23:00. You can also support after returning home.

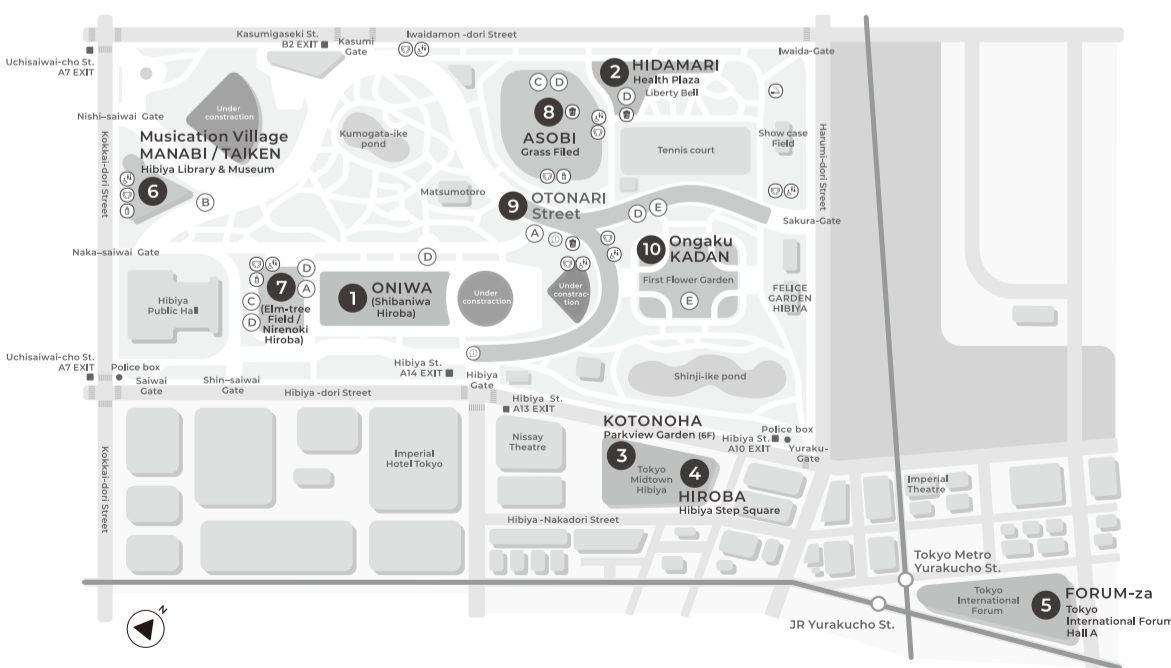
Stage Descriptions

- ONIWA — Hibiya Park Shibaniwa Hiroba**
A spacious lawn area used for live performances. Perfect for families, adults and children can relax on picnic sheets and enjoy concerts and dance workshops in an open, comfortable environment.
Note: In the lawn area, the use of chairs with legs, tents, and tarps, as well as bringing pets, is prohibited. Baby strollers are allowed, but please refrain from driving them on the lawn to protect the grass.
- HIDAMARI (Hibiya Park - Wellness Plaza)**
Located in the plaza overlooking the Bell of Freedom, this stage features mainly acoustic live performances. Note: A food and drink area is also available, allowing visitors to relax and enjoy the atmosphere at their own pace.
- KOTONOHA — Parkview Garden (Tokyo Midtown Hibiya 6F)**
A rooftop garden space with greenery and an open atmosphere. Ideal for acoustic performances, intimate workshops, and cultural programs.
Note: Please refrain from entering the lawn area with wheelchairs. Viewing is available from paved areas. Pets are not allowed inside Tokyo Midtown Hibiya (including the Atrium, stores, terraces, and parking areas), except for guide dogs, assistance dogs, and hearing dogs.
- HIROBA (Tokyo Midtown Hibiya - Step Square)**
An urban stage standing in a plaza surrounded by buildings, where diverse music that transcends genres resonates throughout the Hibiya area. Note: Pets are welcome if leashed or carried (carry bags and pet carts are also permitted).
- FORUM-za (Tokyo International Forum Hall A) *Free ticket required.**
A special collaboration live performance will be held by The Music Park Orchestra, led by Hibiya Music Festival Executive Committee Chair Seiji Kameda, together with a variety of artists and musicians. This is an indoor hall stage.

Event Area Descriptions

- Musication Village - MANABI / TAIKEN (Hibiya Library & Museum B1 Large Hall / 4F Small Hall)**
Talk shows and workshops are held in MANABI (B1 Large Hall) and TAIKEN (4F Small Hall). Enjoy live library concerts on the 3rd floor and collaborative exhibitions with the Hibiya Music Festival at the Note: Eating is not allowed in this area. Only beverages with lids may be brought in. Pets are not permitted (except for guide dogs, assistance dogs, and hearing dogs).
- Nirenoki Plaza**
An area lined with SUPPORTER'S booths and food booths, offering an open view toward the ONIWA stage. Official goods and crowdfunding booths are also available.
- ASOBI (Hibiya Park Lawn Area)**
An area lined with SUPPORTER'S booths and food booths, featuring a mini stage with live performances and workshops for children. There are also playground facilities, making it a fun space for families.
Note: Bringing alcoholic beverages into this area is prohibited. Pets are not allowed (except for guide dogs, assistance dogs, and hearing dogs).
- OTONARI Street (Hibiya Park Pathway)**
Along the park pathway, booths for musical instrument experiences and food stalls are lined up. This normally quiet path becomes lively with booths, creating a special atmosphere full of excitement. Official goods and crowdfunding booths are also available.
Note: Please note that the path from Hibiya Gate to Ongaku KADAN (First Flower Bed) is partially narrowed due to construction.
- Ongaku KADAN (Hibiya Park First Flower Garden)**
In the beautiful lawn and flower garden area, visitors can enjoy various musical instrument experiences and workshops. It is an area where you can encounter new sounds.
Note: Food and drink cannot be brought into this area (only drinking water is allowed for heatstroke prevention). Pets are not allowed (except for assistance dogs such as guide dogs).
